Thriving in Ministry Leadership Cohort Funding Criteria

- For the pilot year, grants will be distributed to mentoring cohorts that consist of no more than 8 ECC clergymen, including a mentor who meets the eligibility requirements for mentors, including one cohort in Canada.
- Eligibility requirements for cohort members: Must hold ECC credentials, be in good standing with the Board of the Ordered Ministry, and have at least 3 years of ministry experience.
- Eligibility requirements for mentors: Must hold ECC credentials, be in good standing with the Board of the Ordered Ministry, and have at least 10 years of ministry experience.
- Successful grant applications will:
 - be typed
 - answer all questions completely
 - include a detailed budget
 - have the potential to raise the visibility of women clergy in the ECC through leadership development and vocational growth
 - fit funding criteria
- Funds will not be provided for operational budgets, loans, etc. Funds should be used toward expenses such as lodging, food, speaker honorariums, travel, etc.
