- The Johnson Center is named in honor of Dr. Tim and Nancy Johnson, who graduated from North Park University in 1956, and Dr. Johnson from North Park Seminary in 1963.
- Dr. Johnson was also Chief Medical Editor for ABC News during his career and is now retired.
- The Johnsons are not only alumni, but also longtime friends of the University who "exemplify North Park's dedication to 'educating students for lives of significance and service," according to University president, Dr. David Parkyn.
- The Johnson Center is anticipated to achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Gold certification.
- Designed to house all science classrooms, plus all aspects of student engagement including Residence Life and Housing, Career Development and Internships, Student Success, International Office, University Ministries, and more.
- \$41 million, from a total of more than \$63 million raised through Campaign North Park, went toward the cost of the Johnson Center.
