Business Prerequisites and Supporting Courses:

The Oakton Community College courses described below may be used to meet requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree in Business and Economics at North Park University. These courses also provide the core for the Bachelor of Science degree in Business and Economics, which requires the selection of one or more concentrations. Please contact North Park University Admissions with any questions.

For admittance into the major you must:

1. Have an overall GPA of 2.50. A transfer student's overall GPA is calculated using all of the courses completed at North Park University (NPU) along with the four basic business courses (from NPU or Oakton Community College).
2. Complete Financial Accounting (BSE 2110), Principles of Macroeconomics (BSE 2211), Foundations of Finance (BSE 2310), and Foundations of Marketing (BSE 2610) and earn a 2.5 GPA in those courses with minimum grade of C- in each.
3. **Students transferring courses into the major from outside North Park University must complete at least one half of the required semester hours in their major at North Park University.**
