



RN-to-BSN Degree Completion Transfer Guidelines Harper College Students Transferring to North Park University

RN students may transfer up to 60 credit hours from an accredited school. North Park will later grant 30 additional credit hours for previous nursing coursework for a total of 90 transfer credits. A minimum of 30 semester hours must be earned at North Park to earn a BSN degree. Of those 30 credits, 24 are nursing required courses and six (6) are general education or supporting nursing courses.

All core curriculum requirements may be met by transfer credits. Transfer courses can meet only ONE general education requirement.
