GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Analyze performance and instruct athletes in Basketball techniques and strategies in preparation for and during athletics competition.
- Assists the Head Coach in the coordination of administrative areas of program management including, but not limited to, scheduling of competitions and practices, travel plans, and equipment.
- Assist program with all phases of competitive NCAA and CCIW compliant recruiting.
- Execute practice and tournament planning/evaluation, including video coordination and breakdown.
- Assist with monitoring the academic progress of all student-athletes on the team.
- Manage equipment usage.
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Head Coach, Associate Athletic Directors, and the Assistant Vice President for Athletics and Sport Management.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A bachelor's degree is required.
- Applicants must be able to work an untraditional work schedule (i.e. frequent nights and weekends).
- Applicant must obtain acceptance in North Park University graduate program and have a personal commitment to North Park's mission of Christian higher education.
- Coaching experience or playing experience and extensive knowledge of the sport of Basketball at the intercollegiate level is required.
- A valid driver's license is required.
