<u>Department:</u> SHHS – School of Nursing (undergraduate program)

- RN, MSN, 2-years' clinical experience as an RN required, board-certified preferred
- PhD. or DNP preferred
- Experience teaching undergraduate nursing students

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide a student-centered learning environment, which enables students to attain success.
- Maintain program and course outcomes at a level to ensure appropriate workplace competency levels for graduates.
- Reporting concerns regarding student academic progress to Academic Advisors and Program Director.
- Refer students with questions regarding financial aid, academics, attendance, and personal issues or concerns to the appropriate departments.
- Actively assisting the Schools in retention efforts.
- Collaborate with School faculty regarding course and program curricular development and evaluation.
- Participate in course, program, and institutional assessment and quality improvement as assigned.

- Regularly attend and participate in faculty meetings.
- Assist Director and Dean in developing and implementing new programs as assigned.
- Remain current with trends, techniques, and advances in technology in health care.
- Maintain open and timely communication with students through the University's e-mail.
- Provide students with appropriate guidance regarding academic excellence and attendance.
- Model professionalism and Christian ethics.
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Academic Director or Dean.
- Maintain and submit accurate and timely reports for student grades.
