

FOOTBALL GRADUATE ASSISTANT (3 POSITIONS)

There are three positions available (1- Offense, 1- Defense, and 1- Recruiting/Digital media). The assistantships include tuition remission, a partial meal plan, and a \$3,000 stipend per semester.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assists the head coach in the coordination of administrative areas of program management including, but not limited to, player development, scheduling of competitions and practices, travel plans, and equipment.
- Analyze performance and instruct athletes in Football techniques and strategies in preparation for and during athletics competition.
- Assist program with all phases of competitive NCAA and CCIW compliant recruiting.
- Execute practice and game planning/evaluation, including scouting, video coordination and breakdown.
- Assist with monitoring the academic progress of student-athletes on the team.
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Head Coach, Assistant Coaches, Associate Athletic Directors, and the Assistant Vice President for Athletics and Sport Management.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A bachelor's degree is required.
- Applicants must be able to work an untraditional work schedule (i.e. frequent nights and weekends).
- Applicant must obtain acceptance in North Park University graduate program and have a personal commitment to North Park's mission of Christian higher education.
- Coaching experience or playing experience and extensive knowledge of the sport of Football at the intercollegiate level is required.
