On March 11, 2021, the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan (ARP). The act provides emergency relief funds to organizations and individuals affected by the coronavirus pandemic. The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), found in Section 18004 of the CARES Act, provides funding to institutions of higher education “to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.” This report includes information on expenditures under Award No. P425E200431-20B to North Park University as Supplemental Funding under ARP for Student Emergency Aid.
