

## **Student Conduct COVID-19 Sanction Guidelines**

It is the expectation that all community members will adhere to the University's face covering policy. Should students be found to be in violation of this standard, they should expect to go through the student conduct process.

Failure to Participate In Contact Tracing or report a positive COVID-19 Test.  When a student is contacted by a University contact tracer, they are expected to respond within 24 hours.	Mandated meeting with the Director of Residence Life and Housing; Student Conduct Probation Level II for 2 semesters; \$150 fine	Mandated meeting with Dean of Students; Required move to virtual learning; Deferred Suspension; Housing Termination (if contracted resident); \$200 fine		
Not Adhering to Testing Policy	Automatic Outcome; Warning	Automatic Outcome; Student Conduct Probation Level I for 1 semester; \$100 fine	Mandated meeting with Director of Residence Life and Housing; Student Conduct Probation Level II for 2 semesters; \$150 fine	Mandated meeting with Dean of Students; Deferred Suspension; Housing Termination (if contracted resident); \$200 fine

- Supervisors, coaches, directors, and other staff personnel will be notified of violations, asappropriate.
