Dear Graduates,

It is customary—and my great privilege—to offer you a brief "charge" on the occasion of your graduation.

The Charge to the Graduates is a final message to the graduating class. It offers you a word of advice, encouragement, and counsel—and it sets out our hopes and expectations for you—as you leave this campus that has been your educational home. This is, of course, a bittersweet moment for us as we prepare to say goodbye ...

We cannot presume to know all the paths that you will travel or the opportunities you will seize, but we can offer the assurance that you are well prepared—you have demonstrated your willingness to work hard—and now it will be up to YOU to take hold of what comes next.

As a Christian university, we have the freedom and the opportunity to turn to Scripture as a guide and encouragement in all that we do. And tonight, as we prepare to depart from each other, we can take our lead from the Apostle Paul's message to the Philippians, written from a prison in Rome. Paul had established the first church in Europe at the city of Philippi. He and his people had spent significant time living and learning together, and the people he taught held a special place in his heart.

In his letter, Paul expresses a loving remembrance of the PAST, a celebration of the PRESENT, and words of strong empowerment for the FUTURE. Words of joy, fellowship, and hope. These are very appropriate words for tonight.

The Apostle Paul:

"I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now ... And being confident of this—that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion, until the day of Christ Jesus. It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart ... And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight ... to the glory and praise of God."
