GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists the head coach with the daily operations of both the men's and women's golf programs at North Park University.
- Analyze performance and instruct athletes in golf techniques and strategies in preparation for and during athletics competition.
- Assist program with all phases of competitive NCAA and CCIW compliant recruiting.
- Build and sustain positive relationships with student-athletes, parents, alumni, faculty, staff, and the campus community.
- Assist with monitoring academic progress of all student-athletes on the team.
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Head Coach, Associate Athletic Directors, and the Assistant Vice President for Athletics and Sport Management.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A bachelor's degree is required.
- Applicants must be able to work an untraditional work schedule (i.e. frequent nights and weekends).
- Applicant must obtain acceptance in a North Park University graduate program.
- Personal commitment to North Park's mission of Christian higher education.
- Coaching experience or playing experience and extensive knowledge of the sport of golf are required.
- A valid driver's license is required.
