

DIRECT ENTRY MASTERS IN NURSING (DEMSN) FACULTY

North Park University seeks faculty for the proposed Direct Entry master's in nursing (DEMSN) scheduled to launch in January 2023 in Chicago, IL. Position start date is August 2022.

About North Park:

Founded in 1891, North Park University is a Christian university affiliated with the Evangelical Covenant Church of over 3,200 students from around the country and world. Located for over 125 years on the land of the Miami and Potawatomi tribes in what is today Chicago's northside, NPU has recently been designated a Hispanic Serving Institution and is committed to serving diverse populations. The primary responsibilities for this position include course development, classroom/online/clinical teaching, and student advisement to advance student success in the proposed DEMSN program (year-round). Workload may include teaching in either the BSN or graduate program. In addition, the faculty will work collaboratively to support and identify retention strategies, provide faculty support, and evaluate student data. It is a 12-month a year position with benefits and a competitive salary.

The faculty reports to the DEMSN Program Director in the SNHS and collaborates with the BSN and Graduate Program faculty to ensure the program aligns with AACN Essentials.

- Be licensed to practice or eligible to practice as a registered nurse (unencumbered) in the State of IL
- Have at least 2-years of experience as a registered nurse
