USING BIBLE COMMENTARIES


Bible commentaries are located in the reference section, which is on the first floor of the library behind the reference desk.



The commentary section starts on the second shelf under the call number BS. Commentaries are shelved in the order that the books appear in the Bible.



When you look up a passage in a commentary, you'll typically find the text of the scripture along with commentary that analyzes and interprets the passage you're studying.



We have several commentaries for each book of the Bible. It's worthwhile to consult more than one, because different commentators will offer different perspectives on the passage you're studying. If you're new to studying theology, the NIV Commentaries, World Commentaries, and Anchor Bible Commentaries are all good commentaries to start with.



You'll need to provide a citation in your paper for every commentary you use. Grove City College has a good list of <u>sample citations for Bible commentaries.</u>
