



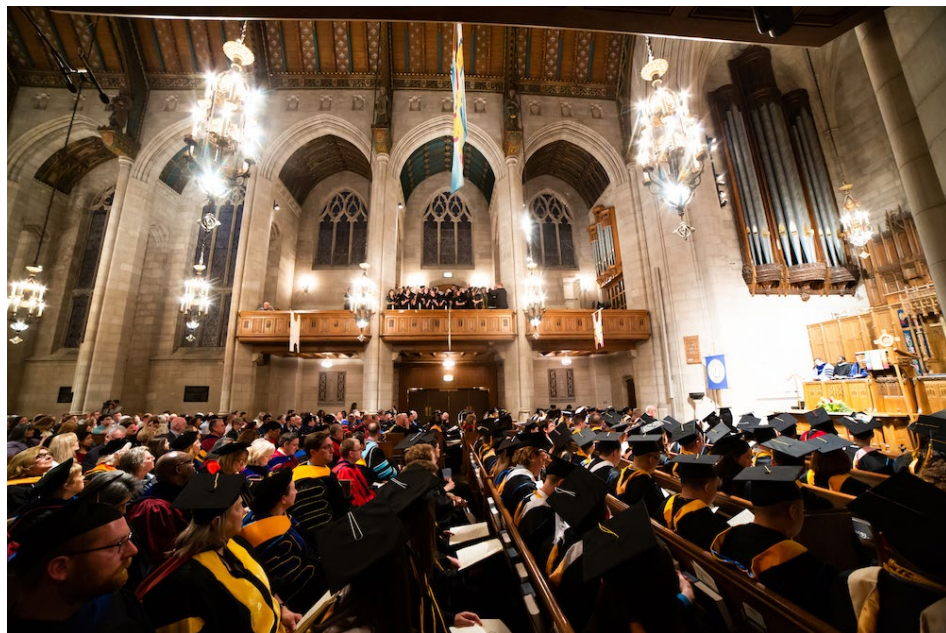

All graduates are encouraged to attend this opportunity to worship, reflect on this rite of passage, hear a keynote speaker, and enjoy students' musical talents. Graduates will begin to assemble for the process in caps, gowns, and hoods at 6:45 pm. Tickets are not required for faculty, staff, family, and friends who wish to attend the Baccalaureate Service.

Fourth Presbyterian Church:

The main entrance to the church is on North Michigan Avenue between Delaware Place and Chestnut. (Across from the John Hancock Center.)

If you are parking at 900 North Michigan, you may gain access into Fourth Presbyterian Church from the entrance to the Gratz Center which is located at 115 E. Delaware St.

Travel from North Park University:

Via Car: Travel east on Foster Ave. to Lake Shore Dr. Travel south on Lake Shore Dr., exiting at Michigan Ave. Parking is in the 900 N. Michigan Self-Park Garage. The entrance to this garage is either on Rush Street (northbound) or Walton (westbound).

Via El: Either walk to the brown line and transfer to the red line, (at Belmont or Fullerton) or take the Foster bus east to the red line. Once on the red line, heading south, exit at Chicago Ave. (and State Street). The church is three blocks east and two blocks north.

Parking:

If you park in the 900 North Michigan Self-Park Garage, reduced rates will apply after 5:00 p.m. with a special validation ticket that will be made available from our ushers upon entrance to the baccalaureate service. You will need both the ticket received upon entrance to the garage and the validation ticket to receive the reduced rate.
