## POLICY

## **Reason for Policy**

To provide clear guidelines on where, how, and by whom chalking is permitted on campus, while ensuring alignment with community standards and respect for others.

#### Scope:

This policy applies to all members of the campus community, including students, faculty, staff, and sponsored guests or groups.

## **Policy Elements**

- Chalking is only permitted on flat, horizontal sidewalks open to the elements.
- Only water-soluble (sidewalk) chalk may be used.
- Chalking may only be done by Student Government Association, Registered Student Organizations or groups sponsored by a university office or department.
- Chalking must adhere to the Student Handbook and Community Standards.
- Prohibited content includes hateful or derogatory messages or symbols. Violations may result in removal and conduct proceedings.

- Prohibited areas include any vertical surfaces or non-sidewalk locations (e.g., benches, buildings, trees, trash receptacles, etc.).
- Only the original chalking party or University maintenance staff may remove or alter chalking.
- "Counter-chalking" will be monitored and discouraged; however, opposing viewpoints are protected.

# **Definitions:**

- *Chalking:* Use of water-soluble chalk on outdoor, horizontal sidewalks.
- *Counter-chalking:* Chalking that responds to or alters the message of existing chalking, often with an opposing viewpoint.

## Procedures:

- 1. Groups wishing to chalk should confirm their registered status.
- 2. Use only water-soluble chalk on approved surfaces.
- 3. Avoid any content in violation of university conduct policies.
- 4. University staff may remove non-compliant chalking or perform regular cleanings.

*COMPLAINT PROCEDURE:* Students, faculty, and staff who suspect violations of the chalking policy should report their concern to university officials. They may do so by filing a report with
